

Lana'i Community Bulletin Board

Rules

The Lānaʻi Post Office in partnership with Pūlama Lānaʻi and the Coalition for Drug Free Lānaʻi (CDFL) provides a community bulletin board for the Lānaʻi Community. Posting of notices does not indicate the partnership endorsement of the ideas, issues or events promoted by those notices.

- All notices posted on the community bulletin board must contain the name and contact information of the sponsoring agency and/or its authorized representative.
- One notice per event or issue is permitted.
- Notices are to be no larger than 8 ½ x 11 inches (letter) size paper in portrait layout only.
- Notices will be accepted no more than 21 days prior to your scheduled event, notices will be removed when they are no longer timely, within a seven day period from posting, or when space is required for more current items.
- The partnership assumes no responsibility for the preservation or protection of any materials posted.
- In fairness to the numerous community groups, the CDFL may control the frequency with which notices may be posted by the same organization.
- Religious organizations may post special events.
- Posting information of illegal or criminal nature or that violates good conduct is prohibited.

Postings may be dropped off at the CDFL office by sliding your posting under the door in a manila envelope. We reduce, reuse and recycle.
