Pivot to "open house – in person format"



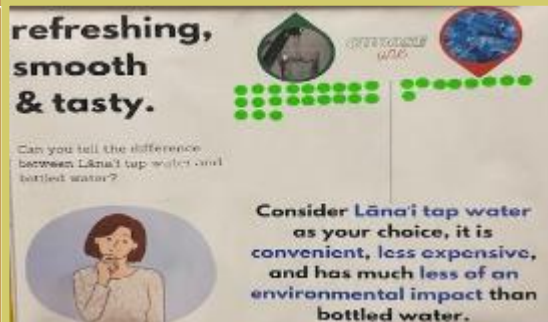
2023 Year of the Kāhuli

After nearly four years of virtual meetings, we have pivoted to an in-person "open house" format.

Lānaʻi tap water prevailed, as the preferred choice over bottled water. Tap water has a much lower impact on our environment.

We continue to share conservation measures, stewarding our water resources.
