Community Meeting Summary: June 29, 2020

Safety

- Use masks in public
- Practice social distancing
- Practice good hygiene – wash your hands
- Stay at home especially if over 65



Pūlama Lāna‘i is Cautiously Reopening

Phased in approach

- Started with outdoor activities
- Construction began June 16
- Hotel Lāna‘i opened June 17
- Mānele & Kō‘ele resorts opened on July 1

Pūlama Lāna‘i Operations

- Increased sanitation protocols in workplace
- Mandatory PPE and social distance rules
- Alternative work schedules
- Implement strategies to limit contact with visitors in the workplace

Travel

- Residents may travel off island and return without having to quarantine
- Day travelers return
- Construction contractors return
- No quarantine necessary if traveling from intrastate after August 1, with a negative PCR test

Resort Operations

- Guests are required to wear masks in public areas
- Masks are provided for guests
- Resort employee safety protocols in place

Development and Construction

- Daily health status monitoring
- Limit contact with community for non-resident workers (i.e., meal delivery & grocery curbside pickup, keep to home and jobsite)
- Outdoor recreation encouraged outside of the community

Moving Forward

- Collaboration with HIEMA, providing quarantine sites
- Serious COVID-19 cases sent off island
- Support contact tracing efforts
- Bring testing capabilities with faster results

Began June 2020
Tentative end in early 2022
- Observatory
Begin work mid-August 2020
- Amphitheater
Received Project District Phase II approval
Begin work first half of 2021
