DEFINITION OF RESIDENT: A resident is a person who permanently resides on the island of Lāna'i. It also includes new permanent Company employees (not seasonal), taking up residency on Lāna'i. It does not include non-resident owners or individuals who are temporarily employed on Lana'i by non-resident employers (contractors, etc.). To check residency status, we will use such criteria as post office box, driver's license address, voter's registration, tax "home", etc.
