

2021 Non- Lānaʻi Resident Hunting Rules

Pūlama Lānaʻi is now accepting limited numbers of reservations (Rifle and Shotgun) for off-island hunters. In the interest of safety, additional restrictions are in place. We are excited to bring off-island hunters back to Lānaʻi, but please take these rules to heart; they are in place because all it takes is one bad decision the program to shut down again, or worse yet, for COVID to spread on our remote island.

Rules are subject to change with little to no notice, and reservations may be canceled by Pūlama Lānaʻi at any time. In addition to applicable federal, state, and county rules (which hunters are responsible for knowing), the following rules are in effect immediately.

Hunting Area Reservations (Shotgun and Rifle) for non- Lānaʻi residents:

- Earliest hunt date is Feb 1, 2021.
- Reservations will only be accepted less than 6-weeks in advance.
- Reservations will be accepted for up to twenty (20) off-island hunters per week, first-come, first-serve. There is no limit to the number of Lānaʻi resident hunters.
- Hunting groups are restricted to five (5) hunters.

COVID Testing: ALL off-island hunters are required to obtain a COVID PCR test within three (3) days of arrival on Lānaʻi. THIS INCLUDES RESIDENTS OF MOLOKAʻI AND MAUI. Hunters without a negative test may NOT hunt.

Contact Tracing: In the case of a positive COVID case, in addition to the standard information collected for permits (name, home address, phone number, etc.) we will collect.

- Lānaʻi place of lodging.
- Lānaʻi vehicle rental (make, model, license plate).
- Note: this information will be shared with MPD, DoCARE and Pūlama Lānaʻi Security to aid in tracing.
- Note: Current county rules require visitors from outside Maui County to download and use the AlohaSafe Alert app on their phone for contact tracing as well.

We strongly encourage hunters to minimize interaction with Lānaʻi residents and between hunting groups. Most of all, please minimize trips to public spaces (grocery stores, restaurants, private residences, gas station etc.)

- If you have to go to the grocery store, send **one** person and buy as much as you can in one trip.
- Consider using the 'Rosie' app which allows customers to remotely order food and pickup without going inside at Richards (available through the app store).
- Several restaurants are offering takeout and delivery.
- Do not attend large gatherings (house parties, etc.). Current country rules limits gatherings of non-family members to a maximum of 5.

Failure to follow the spirit or letter of the rules and regulations in place to minimize COVID transmission will result in immediate suspension of hunting privileges. Severe, repeated, or egregious infractions will be treated with the same severity as poaching (5-year – permanent suspension of hunting privileges).
