OUR COMMITMENT TO SERVING LĀNA'I

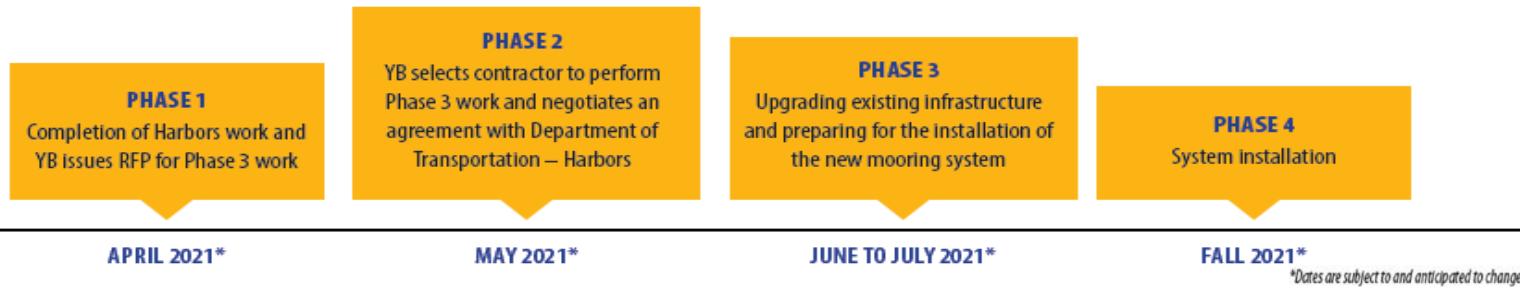
How will Young Brothers' investment in a new mooring system help Lāna'i?

- These improvements will enhance safety for Young Brothers' crews loading and unloading vessels in the port.
- This pilot project – the first in the nation – will allow YB to safely discharge and pick-up cargo in rough seas and indement weather.
- The upgrades will ensure Young Brothers can provide the reliable service that the people of Lāna'i depend on.



PROJECT TIMELINE

There will be minimal to no impacts on Young Brothers' operations at the Kaunalapau Port during the project.

Pūlama Lāna'i COVID-19 policy changes for contractors and consultants due to increased levels of vaccination effective April 5

We will continue these policies (not an exhaustive list)

- Wear a mask, practice safe social distancing, and frequent handwashing
- Follow all State and County rules for COVID-19
 - Including gathering sizes
- A negative COVID-19 PCR or approved test must be received prior to travel
- Upon arrival all workers must complete temperature check
- Daily jobsite temperature check and questionnaire completed

Adjusted Policies

- Aqua wrist bands are no longer required
- No restrictions into the community
 - Able to get their own gas and food
- Access to Richard's Market during the following hours, daily
 - Morning: 6:00 – 7:00am
 - Evening: 7:00 – 9:00pm
