How do I apply?

1. Contact Lānaʻi Kīnāʻole (LK) or your PCP for an application
2. Contact a LCF board member for an application
3. Submit completed application with a copy of your identification to Lānaʻi Kīnāʻole

Confidentiality Provisions

- All LK staff and LCF board members sign a Confidentiality Agreement
- Those breaching agreement may be terminated from employment or asked to resign from LCF
- Safeguarding of confidentiality continues after termination or resignation

What happens next?

1. LK processes application, verifies residency & diagnosis, notifies board for review & approval
2. After review & approval by three board members, the patient receives a \$500 stipend
3. Up to \$1000 in treatment related expenses is provided
4. Treatment related expenses include transportation (air, sea, ground), lodging, food, medications and /or out-of pocket medical costs.

First Charity Golf Tournament was a huge success

After expenses the LCF doubled their goal, raising ~\$20k
